

Annual AHERA Notification to Parents, Teachers, and Staff

Dear Parents, Teachers, and Staff,

Child Guidance Resource Center (CGRC) is providing this letter in accordance with the 40 CFR Part 763 (enacted by Congress in 1986) of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act, more commonly referred to as AHERA. This rule requires all Local Education Agencies (LEA's) to identify asbestos containing materials (ACMs) in their school buildings and take appropriate actions to prevent and control the release of asbestos fibers. ACM inspections have been completed for the CGRC portion of the building located at 2000 Old West Chester Pike, Havertown, Pennsylvania. An Asbestos Management Plan has been prepared and is available for review in the CGRC's administrative office during regular operating hours. The Asbestos Management Plan identifies these ACMs throughout the CGRC building and establishes specific inspection and maintenance protocols for the identified materials.

CGRC takes the health and care of our students seriously, and we would like to inform you that there are currently no friable ACMs located in the first, second, or third floor of the CGRC building. The majority of the third floor, where children spend all their time, is also free of any non-friable ACMs, with the exception of a small IT storage closet where asbestos containing mastic (glue) is present beneath non-ACM floor tile. Given this mastic is encapsulated with floor tile, the potential for student contact is non-existent. The Management Plan also identifies other ACMs located in remaining portions of the building; however, student access is completely restricted in these areas.
